

NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS READ THIS CAREFULLY

Concerning your property tax bill. The tax year begins July 01, and, by state law, property taxes are assessed TO THE OWNER OF RECORD AS OF APRIL 01.

SOME THINGS TO NOTE: You MUST retain the upper portion of your bill. You need this to file your income taxes.

1. Remember: THESE TAX RATES REFLECT BUDGETS AND MOTIONS APPROVED AT TOWN MEETING THE PREVIOUS MARCH.
2. If this property changed hands between April 01 and the date of the receipt of this bill, both parties will receive a copy. Please see the second notice addressing this issue included in this envelope.
3. If you own a quarter-share condo, the management company or association paying your taxes has received a copy of this bill also. Please see the second notice addressing this issue included in this envelope.
4. Payments may be made by mail, at the office or left in the drop box at the front door of the office. Postmarks of the due date are acceptable.
5. You may make weekly or monthly payments, just call.
6. There is a 1% interest fee on late installments and 8% penalty on all delinquent taxes. Late installment notices will be mailed monthly after each payment becomes due.
7. Do not send post dated checks without notifying the office first.
8. All taxes must be paid with U.S. Funds.
9. For a copy of the Property Tax Policy see the Town Report.
