

MINUTES FROM THE SELECT BOARD MEETING ON FEBRUARY 05, 2007

Board members present were John Devine, RJ Vallie, Gene Armstrong and Pat Mallow. Also present was Town Clerk Deborah LaRivière. The meeting was called to order at 5:50pm.

*John motioned: “To accept the minutes from the January 22, 2007 meeting. Gene seconded. There were no changes, all were in favor, motion passed.

*Deb will bring Ray Atwood’s request for use of the Sara Holbrook land for his dirt bike group to Town Attorney Robert Fletcher.

Since accepting the resignation of Dick Ward as Zoning Administrator, the town is without a Health Officer. John motioned: “To appoint Deborah LaRivière as Health Officer.” Seconded by Pat. All were in favor, motion passed.

*RJ brought the Board up to speed on the health issue he investigated last week. The Board would like the property owner contacted to see if an agreement could be reached before issuing a condemnation health order. Deb will do.

*Tara Hamilton of the Catamount Trail Association met with the Board to review a recent sale of land to the Nature Conservancy. Her organization, (CTA) is looking for a support letter from the town for this project. John motioned: “To support the sale of the Rolling Hills property to the Nature Conservancy.” RJ seconded. There was no other discussion, all were in favor, motion passed.

Jen Andrews met with the Board representing the Planning Commission. She brought along a letter of support from the PC for the proposed park and ride that the Board has been discussing with the Agency of Transportation.

Pat asked that a violation letter be sent to John Reynolds. The fence surrounding his debris pile has fallen down and several new vehicles have appeared on the property. Deb will draft a letter.

The Board would like an ad placed in the Free Press for a new zoning administrator. Deb will do.

There was no other business to be brought before this Board at this time. John motioned to end the meeting, seconded by Gene. The meeting closed at 7:30.
