The Board reviewed the Public Works budget. Not all the figures are complete. The Board would like bid letters sent out for propane and fuel for the upcoming year. Quotes should be requested from; Newtons, Pattersons, Stevens and Ultramar. Deb will do. The Board continued reviewing budgets, looking at the General Fund accounts. A more in-depth discussion regarding health insurance will take place at a future meeting. Tom will stop in and adjust the thermostat in the office so it drops a few degrees at night and prior to the onset of the weekend. The back door continues to be a problem due to rain and snow fall off the roof. Deb will call Don Morin and see what might be done.

The Board would like to continue a highway discussion with Road Foreman Eric Andrews at the December 3 meeting.

Cemetery caregiver Dick Streeter, Sr. has requested an article on the town warning for a fence for the Route 2 cemetery. Deb will get a price from Middlebury Fence for the board.

John motioned: *"To accept the minutes from the November 19, 2007 meeting."* Tom seconded. There was one correction; the date of December 01 should be December 03. The question was called. All were in favor of accepting the minutes with that correction.

Tom Longstreth of Stage Road had a vehicle incident involving some frozen dirt in the travelled portion of the road. The Board declined reimbursing Longstreth for the damage. Deb will draft a letter and Tom will stop in and sign.
