RJ motioned: "To accept the minutes from the October 20, 2008 meeting." John seconded. All were in favor, motion passed.

The Board reviewed an Act 250 application for Bolton Woods.

The Board read a letter from Erin Perkins requesting an appointment to the Planning Commission. The Board will pass this along to the PC.

Warrants were signed.

Leslie Pelch met with the Board to go over a new program designed to help owners who have purchased parcels of land that may have potential hazardous waste located on them. Information on the Brownfield Program is available through Regional Planning. Deb will put a brief item in a future newsletter.

The Board continued its' discussion regarding the Notch Road erosion problem. John and RJ met recently with Dave and Sue Beckman, who own the gravel pit. The Board is considering a reserve fund budget line item for future repair of the road. The Beckman's indicated that they were be willing to contribute materials when the town decides to do any repairs. An engineering study would probably be the first step and perhaps some discussion at town meeting.

There was no other business to be brought before this Board at this time. Tom motioned to end the meeting, seconded by Gene. The meeting ended at 6:30 pm.
